**3. APPROVAL OF PHASE 2 FURNITURE FINAL COSTS**

Chris states this is to approve the final pricing we received for furniture for the building. We will then give it to Finance to issue purchase orders. Chris shows a slideshow presentation of the original estimate that was given to the building committee in July. The estimate was \$2,293,000.00. The State final pricing came back at \$2,215,000.00. The recap sheet is shown with the vendors. The only piece of furniture that we don't have accounted for is the piano. The piano is not available on State contracts. JCJ is working with another cooperative purchasing contract to get a quote. All of the vendors are aware that we are going to be requesting the furniture phase by phase and they will deliver it as it is needed.

Randy states we are about \$78,000.00 less than what the budget was when we started. In actuality, we are about \$300,000.00 less. We pulled some money out of this line item when we put it out to bid. We are in great shape.

Kevin asks if we are still doing good with materials and supplies?

Randy states on furniture we are fine, building material we haven't had any hiccups.
