


Water Pollution Control Facility (“WPCF”) and Collection System Project Timeline



Fast Track Design of the WPCF

In November of 2015 Enfield voters passed a referendum to fund the design and construction of wastewater treatment facility and collection system upgrades. The contract for design was awarded in August of 2016 to Woodard & Curran, of 1699 King Street. The Enfield WPCF was a late addition to the Clean Water Fund priority list, necessitating a *fast track design* to remain eligible for State funding. The fast track timeline required 90% design to be completed by Spring of 2017.



What is Your Sewer Use Fee Doing?

The \$36 million dollar project includes significant upgrades to the WPCF, which was built in 1972, the sewer collection system and pump stations. A combination of grants, loans, and the sewer use fee will fund your project.


