

**Town of Enfield Nondiscrimination Public Notice
Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964**


The Town of Enfield hereby gives public notice of its **Nondiscrimination Policy** to ensure compliance with the Title IV of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and as supplemented by all related statutes and regulations, which applies to any and all Town services, programs, and activities that are Federally funded.

Any person who believes that he or she has individually, or as a member of any specific class of persons, been excluded from participation in, been denied the benefit of, or otherwise been subjected to discrimination under any Town service, program of activity, and believe that the discrimination is based on race, color, national origin, gender, age income, disability, or limited ability to speak English, has the right to file a formal complaint.


Complaints will be accepted in writing and may be filed with the Town's Title VI Coordinator within 180 days from the date of the alleged act of discrimination.
