And there is **no fee** to display as a vendor each week. All we ask is you set up one hour before we open at 4:30 p.m.

If you are selling or offering samples of prepared foods, please do not forget to display your Board of Health License or temporary food permit from North Central District Health Department (NCDHD). For your convenience, a modified temporary food permit fee will be provided.
