*Childcare will be available along with a light dinner to take home. Space is limited so please reserve your spot today!

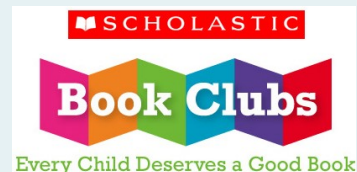

SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT IS THE FOCUS OF OUR PLAY GROUPS FOR MARCH AND APRIL

Social-emotional development includes the child's experience, expression, and management of emotions and the ability to establish positive relationships with others. Here are some tips to encourage social-emotional development:

Infants

- Talk, hum, sing and read to your baby often, especially during daily routines such as feeding and diaper changing.
- Recognize, name, and respect their feelings and talk about what they seem to be "saying."

Toddlers

- Give choices whenever possible. For example, "Do you want to wear the blue shirt or the red shirt?" This will help them feel in control.
- Model sharing and turn-taking. Small amounts of waiting help children to learn self control and recognize that others have needs, too.

Preschoolers

- Acknowledge children's feelings and give them the words to express emotions appropriately. For example, "I can see that you are feeling sad."
- Read books about people and animals who express different emotions in a variety of settings.
