

PROGRAM POLICIES RELATED TO COVID-19

- **If you or anyone in your household does not feel well for ANY REASON, please do not attend the program.**
- Please notify us if you or someone in your household tests positive for COVID-19 on the day of the program or in the 14 days immediately following.
- Please do not arrive more than 5 minutes prior to the start of your session time.
- Masks **MUST** be worn by participants during non-active times, such as signing in and out, using the restroom and down time between drills and games.
- Sign in and out will be held in the lobby. Sign in and out will be contactless and conducted verbally. When signing in and out please maintain social distance between yourself and others.
- One parent/guardian per participant is **REQUIRED** to attend the program. Only one parent/guardian is allowed per participant. Parents/guardians must wear a mask at all times.
- Upon arrival, a daily visual and verbal health screening will be conducted by program staff.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided and available during the program. Hands must be sanitized after signing in, after using the restroom and as needed during the program.
- Peer-to-peer and instructor-to-peer contact will not be allowed at any time during the program.
- Equipment will not be shared to the best extent possible. Equipment will be sanitized before and after each session and during the program as needed.
- Personal items, such as water bottles, will **NOT** be shared during the program.
- Participants must follow all staff directions to keep socially distanced throughout the program.
- Participants should bring all of their belongings with them when they leave - any items left behind will be discarded.
