Day 1: Arrive San Diego

The library also features the **Air Force One** used by President Reagan. Later follow the Pacific Coast north to **Santa Barbara**, one of California's most picturesque cities with spectacular Mediterranean architecture. Continue to **Shell Beach**, a quaint seaside town for your overnight stay.

Meal - (B) Overnight: Shell Beach

Day 5: Shell Beach - Carmel/Monterey

Today travel to San Simeon to enjoy a tour of **Hearst Castle**. Built on a hilltop overlooking the Pacific, the spectacular grounds and grandiose home feature the world-class art collection of newspaper magnate William Randolph Hearst. Then journey north along the spectacular **Big Sur Coast**. Later enjoy scenic

17 Mile Drive, home to the famous Lone Cypress and Pebble Beach Golf Course. Visit the historic seaside town of **Monterey**, where Cannery Row and Fisherman's Wharf reflect the city's long history with the sea. Also explore quaint **Carmel** to stroll down tree-lined Ocean Avenue past unique shops and art galleries.

Meal - (B) Overnight: Monterey

Day 6: Carmel/Monterey - Yosemite National Park

Journey inland through the fertile San Joaquin Valley, known as the breadbasket of California. Stop at a historic fruit stand for a chance to buy fresh-off-the-farm fruits. Climb into the wooded **Sierra Nevada Mountains** and arrive at **Yosemite National Park**. Enter the spectacular Yosemite Valley to view the giant iconic formations of **El Capitan & Half Dome** and breathtaking **Yosemite Falls**, the highest in North America. Enjoy a stroll and take in the immense beauty of this spectacular mountain setting. Enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers tonight.

Day 7: Sacramento - Napa Valley - San Francisco
