

Departmental Servers Information Sheet

Overview

As part of the Active Directory migration, new HP DL380 or ML350 servers were installed at various locations throughout Town. The primary function of these servers is to place data close to the users and prevent the need to traverse a WAN link to access data. Some of these functions include Active Directory infrastructure, localized storage of departmental group information, personal file storage areas, and department specific databases. All of the data at these distributed locations is backed up using a centralized enterprise backup system. Fault tolerance is designed into each of these servers through the use of redundant power supplies and disk RAID arrays.
