



Enfield Named a Digital Cities Survey Winner for 2007

Nov. 14, 2007, Enfield, CT – The Town of Enfield Information Technology Department is pleased to announce it has been named a Digital Cities Survey Winner for 2007 by the Center for Digital Government.

The 2007 Digital Cities Survey examines how cities use technology to create a seamless environment between local government and constituents.

Top ten cities have a higher total score than the other cities in their category – which reflects a fuller implementation of the benchmarks represented in the questions - the 26 questions and 179 data points are the benchmark areas of technology; reflecting cutting-edge technology and good governance, through implementation and adoption of online service delivery; infrastructure standards and architecture components; and the planning and governance that make the transformation to digital government possible.

The survey is open to all U.S. cities with a population of 30,000 or more and respondent cities are classified into four size-based categories. In the smallest city category, 30,000 to 74,999, Enfield was ranked fourth.

“This year’s winners have really raised the bar for cities,” said Cathilea Robinett, executive director for the Center for Digital Government. “Digital technology connects citizens with their government on a level never before achieved.”
