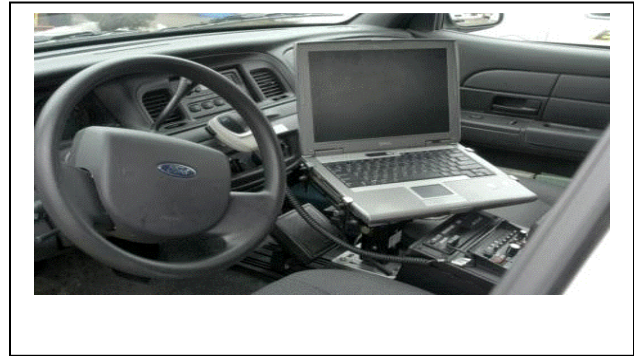


MDT Access Police Records Information System Information Sheet

Overview

To increase the availability of information to Police Officers while on the road, the Police Department and the IT Department took advantage of a service offered by the Capital Region Council of Government (CRCOG). The existing infrastructure for cruiser communications through CRCOG was already in place. A secure connection was installed between the Town's network and the CRCOG datacenter. By installing this protected connection, the mobile data terminals (MDT) in the cruisers now have access to the Town's network. Secure information available to the MDTs includes the Police Records Information System, access to various photographs, General Orders, the Intranet, email, and report writing on the road.



Highlights

- More time can be spent on the streets instead of in the building
- Secure remote access to Town infrastructure resources from their cruiser.
- Town Network security is preserved while allowing access to resources
- Officers have instant access to data while on the road
- Access to PRISE, email, file storage, Report Writing and General Orders

Interaction with Other Systems

- Allows the Patrol Officers to work on the road just as if they were "in the building"
