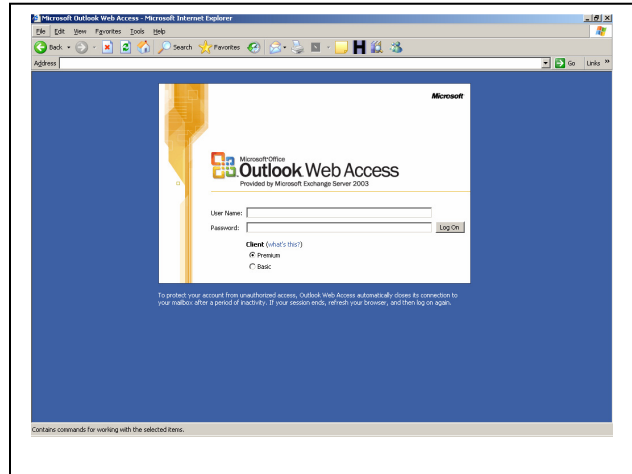


Mail Services Information Sheet

Overview

As part of the infrastructure upgrade to install current Microsoft operating systems and applications, Exchange Server 2003 and Outlook Web Access were installed to replace Exchange 5.5. In conjunction with the Active Directory migration, all user mailboxes and content, as well as Public Folder data was migrated to the new Exchange messaging system. One of the features of Exchange 2003 is the secure web interface access to mailboxes and public folders. Through the Exchange 2003 system, users will have access to the complete Town staff directory, distribution lists, public folders for which they have been granted permission, special contacts lists and event calendaring.
