

Youth Services Information Sheet

Overview

A Computer Learning Center has been established for Youth Services at the Angelo Lamagna Activity Center. The Learning Center computers are a resource for youths to do homework and other activities. Some computers are also available for the Enfield Cooperative Education Program.



The Learning Center computers are setup with Microsoft Windows XP and Microsoft Office XP for completing homework assignments and learning computer skills. Files can be saved to a common location that is accessible to all Youth workstations. A color inkjet printer is available and accessible by all Youth workstations.

The Town of Enfield IT Department centrally administers and supports the computers. The computers are available for automated updates and remote control for support. This increases IT staff efficiency and minimizes downtime at the Youth Center.

- Color printing to an inkjet printer accessible by all workstations.
