

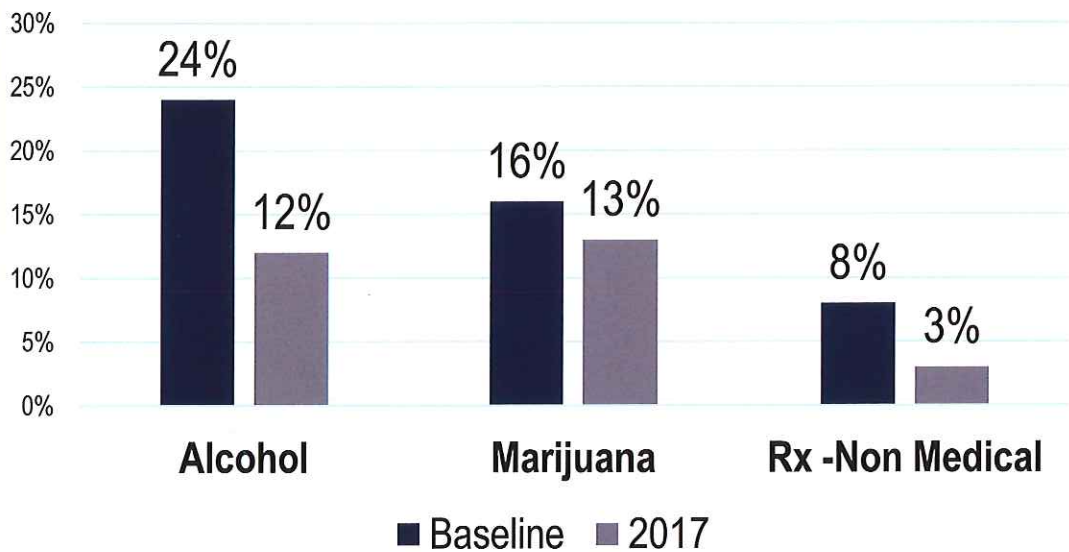

Average age of first use for alcohol, marijuana and non-medical use of prescription drugs

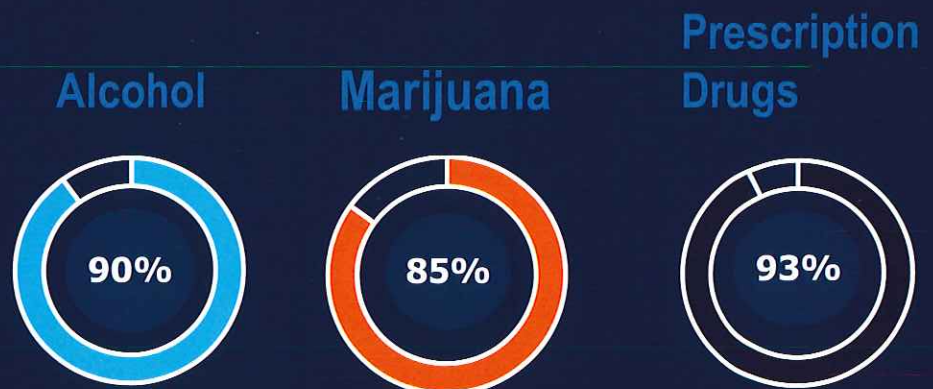
Background:

Since 2009, every 2 years, Enfield students in grades 6-12, have participated in the "Youth Substance Use and Related Behaviors Survey," sponsored by Enfield Together Coalition with a Federal grant from SAMHSA (insert wording here:)
