

Babysitter Safety Course

Ages 11-16 years old

This comprehensive course is intended to teach age appropriate skills necessary to care for children of all ages using team babysitting, mother's helper and individual babysitting concepts. This course focuses on safety with an emphasis on prevention. Other topics covered include handwashing, diapering, bottle feeding, personal safety, interview skills and COVID-19 related topics. Basic first aid, including adult and child CPR, will be covered. Upon passing the written and skills testing, participants will receive a 2-year first aid and CRR certification. Participants will also receive a booklet, handouts and Babysitter Safety Certificate. Participants should bring a pen, bag lunch, snack and water bottle. Due to COVID-19, several additional policies are required of all participants and their families. Please see page 2 for details.

PROGRAM POLICIES RELATED TO COVID-19

- **Participants must complete a self-screening before arriving at the program. If you or anyone in your household does not feel well for any reason, please do not attend the program. Please notify us if you or someone in your household tests positive for COVID-19 on the day of the program or in the 14 days immediately following the program.**
- Participants should not arrive more than 10 minutes before to the start of the program.
- **Participants and parents/guardians will be required to follow all current masking mandates.**
- Upon arrival, a visual health screening will be conducted by program staff.
- Contactless sign in and out will be held outside the Recreation Office. Participants will be required to sanitize their hands at the beginning of the program. Hand sanitizer will be available to use throughout the program as needed.
- Participants must follow all staff directions to keep socially distanced throughout the program. The classroom will be set up to allow for proper social distancing.
- Person-to-person contact will be kept minimal during the program. Rescue breaths will be taught but mouths will never be placed on the manikins.
- Equipment will not be shared to the best extent possible. Used equipment and materials will be sanitized before and after the program and during the program as needed.
- An email will be sent to all registered participants 24-48 hours prior to the program with details, reminders and any updates.
