PROGRAM POLICIES RELATED TO COVID-19

- **Participants and attending parents/guardians must complete a self-screening before arriving to the program. If you or anyone in your household does not feel well for any reason, please do not attend the program. Please notify us if you or someone in your household tests positive for COVID-19 on the day of the program or in the 14 days immediately following your last day of participation.**
- Participants should not arrive more than 10 minutes before to the start of the program.
- **Participants and parents/guardians will be required to follow all current masking mandates.**
- No food or drink (except water) will be allowed during the program.
- Upon arrival, a visual health screening will be conducted by program staff.
- Contactless sign in and out will be held at the Outdoor Classroom. Participants will be required to sanitize their hands at the beginning of the program. Hand sanitizer will be available to use throughout the program as needed.
- Participants must follow staff directions for when to switch opponents and reminders to sanitize their hands after each game.
- Chess sets will be sanitized after each session and staff will follow enhanced hygiene and cleaning protocols when setting up the boards and during the program.
- **Inclement Weather:** Participants will be notified via email of any changes to the program due to inclement weather. This may include moving to an indoor location.
- An email will be sent to registered participants the week before the start of the program with details, reminders and any updates.
