

Fishing Field Trips with CARE

Adults and families with children 8 years and older

Fishing is a lifelong sport that can be enjoyed across generations! If you are looking for a way to practice your skills and gain knowledge of the sport, join the CT DEEP *Connecticut Aquatic Resources Education* (CARE) program this summer for one of two FREE Fishing Field Trips being held at Freshwater Pond. All fishing equipment, bait and expert instruction will be provided for use during the fishing trips. Pre-registration is required and everyone in attendance must register for a spot. Youth 15 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult. Participants 16 years and older MUST have a valid fishing license to participate. Participants are encouraged to bring a folding chair and may bring their own fishing equipment if they prefer. Participants can arrive and leave at any time during the events. Inclement weather may cancel these fishing field trips. Due to COVID-19, several additional policies are required of all participants. Please see page 2 for details. **Limit: 35 each trip.**
