We, who live on South Road, Enfield Street and Post Office Road are well aware that our area has more traffic than other neighborhoods. We accept this because of our love of antique homes and the character and charm of the historic district. We do not need the increase in traffic if the zone change is approved. Because of a line drawn around the project we are now non abutters, as if we don't matter. We know that we are abutters and we do matter.

My husband and I bought an antique home that was in much need of repair and love; we have been working on our property to make it an asset to not only the Historic District but the town of Enfield,

as well.

We are just a group of residents who do not have the deep pockets of Community Builders to hire an attorney to represent us. All research has been done by us and presented by us.
